Law degree, Boalt Hall, University of California at Berkeley (Order of the Coif, Editor in Chief of the California Law Review) 1956. Professor of law, Boalt Hall, 1963 to 1965, teaching courses in income tax, trusts and legal ethics. Part-time professor of law at California Western University and University of San Diego law schools, various times from 1957 through 1980, teaching courses in torts, income tax, equity, corporations, civil procedure. At various times have been licensed as a securities broker with the NASD and as a real estate broker. Served a term as probate referee. Professional articles in various publications, teaching positions with the Continuing Education of the Bar and the Rutter Group.
