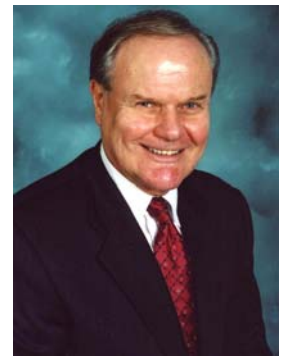




Gil Lasky, Esq.
